Performance Registry of Merit (P-ROM)

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America's (GSPCA) Performance Registry of Merit (P-ROM) award program is to honor the AKC *Companion Events Performance* production record of the sire and dam. It complements the existing conformation based Registry of Merit award (ROM) program. This is also a three tier award. All owners must be GSPCA Members at the time of application for this award.

P-ROM

(Sire): 6 different offspring who have achieved *at least* mid-level titles in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

(Dam): 4 different offspring who have achieved *at least* mid-level titles in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

P-ROMX

(Sire): 12 different offspring who have achieved *at least* a mid-level title in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

(Dam): 6 different offspring who have achieved *at least* mid-level titles in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

P-ROMXX

(Sire): 25 different offspring who have achieved *at least* a mid-level title in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

(Dam): 12 different offspring who have achieved *at least* mid-level titles in AKC obedience, tracking and/or agility.

The following AKC companion events titles will be considered:

- Obedience: **CDX**
- Agility: **OA, OAJ, OAP, OJP** (One standard *and* one jumpers title, both at the open or above level is required.)
- Tracking: **TD**

If a given offspring has mid-level (or higher) achievements in multiple AKC companion events (e.g. obedience and agility) that offspring still counts as one, exactly the same as an offspring that has mid-level achievements in only one companion event.

Since Obedience and Tracking have been offered by the AKC since the 1930's, deceased dogs are eligible.
