Entries received before this date will not be accepted and will be returned to the exhibitor as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the Agility Regulations. **Entries Close on Monday, April 25, 2022, 6:00 p.m. (MDT)** at the Trial Secretary's Address, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted EXCEPT as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.

Entries for German Shorthaired Pointers will be accepted during the entire period starting February 23, 2022 and given priority through March 16, 2022. Entries for all other breeds will be accepted during the entire period in order received but put in priority behind all German Shorthaired Pointer entries received through March 16, 2022. Beginning March 17, 2022, all entries, regardless of breed, will be accepted in order received until the event closing date.

**Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC agility entry form are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Move-up must be made on or before Monday, May 2, 2022 at 6 p.m MDT.

**Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a returned check, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry.

**Owners are responsible** for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

**A maximum of 10 entries** per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

The **German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America** is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Monday April 25, 2022, 6:00 pm MDT. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing April 25, 2022, 6:00 pm MDT. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Monday, April 25, 2022 6:00 p.m. MDT will be replaced by a first received wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Sunday, May 1, 2022 5:00 p.m. MDT will receive a full refund.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees IN FULL for bitches unable to compete for this reason.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

The **German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against GSPCA or officials thereof.

**German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America is NOT accepting online entries. Please mail entries so that they arrive on or before closing.**

**This club** does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

## JUDGING INFORMATION

**Check-In** will begin at **7:00 AM MDT** on all days.

Judging will start at 8:00 AM MDT on all days.

Check-in for all dogs, judge's briefing, and walk through will take place prior to start time. Electronic timers will be used. Excellent/Master level classes, FAST, and Time to Beat may have split walk through depending on entry size.

**Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. Dogs that need to be measured must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. **A VMO WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THESE TRIALS.**

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

## COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. All levels of FAST Classes may be briefed and walked together depending on the size of the entry – final plans for walking and running the FAST classes will be documented in the judging program.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors in a back area outside of the arena area. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple ring may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered if a conflict is anticipated. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

**Measuring and Height Card Information**

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

**NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process**

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

**Dogs Eligible to Enter**

These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

After the close of entries a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 21)

**RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES**

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

- First Place.....Blue
- Second Place..... Red
- Third Place.....Yellow
- Fourth Place .....White
- Qualifying Score.....Dark Green

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. Ribbons and awards will not be mailed. If we are honored to have a Agility Grand Champion Award the GSPCA will order a custom ribbon to recognize this accomplishment after the trial.

## High In Trial for German Shorthaired Pointers Only:

**HIT For German Shorthaired Pointers only:** High in Trial ribbons will be awarded on Sunday and Monday for GSPs only: The German Shorthaired Pointer that earns a QQ from the Regular Excellent or Master Standard and JWW classes and has the highest average yards per second determined by averaging the YPS of the two runs across the Standard and Jumpers classes. If no QQs are earned from the regular classes, then any QQ earned from the Preferred Excellent or Master classes will be considered. If no QQs are earned in either Regular or Preferred, then if a GSP in regular qualifies in Excellent/Master in Regular Standard, it will win. If more than one GSP were to qualify in Standard, the GSP the highest YPS will be used. If none qualify in Regular Standard, then Excellent/Master Preferred Standard will be used. If none in qualify, then Excellent/Master Regular JWW will be used, followed by Excellent/Master Preferred JWW. A HIT Ribbon will be awarded on Each Day of the Event.

## Judy and Bruni Spirit Award

On each day the GSPCA will present a special ribbon award to a person at either set of trials who during that day exhibits the spirit, sportsmanship, and kindness shown by our missed member Judy Shinogle and her GSP Bruni – they were killed by a drunk driver on the way to an agility trial in 2012. We strive to remember their spirit and contributions to the Agility Sport and German Shorthaired Pointer Agility by awarding the most entertaining moment or run – it will be awarded sometime during each trial – all competitors at the trial are eligible – the GSPCA Event Committee will determine the winners each day

No one shall have any recourse or claim against German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc, the Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

**German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc.** will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. German Shorthaired Pointer Club of America, Inc., Club officers, board members, Trial Committee, and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
